- Ask your friend to phone us on 01772 450600 and remind them to mention your name.

Remember to test your Lifeline pendant each month by pressing the button and speaking to an Operator in our Control Centre.

## Do you have a KeySafe?

If you have a KeySafe, our operators will be asking you to confirm your KeySafe code when you make your monthly test call. This will ensure that in the unlikely event of an emergency we are providing the correct number to the emergency services to enable them to gain access to your property. ## Safeguarding adults

Everyday abuse of adults goes unreported. Did you know that local authorities, police, and NHS agencies involved with adults who might be at risk from abuse, have procedures in place that encourage reporting of suspected abuse, and take action to stop abuse.

## Are you over 60?

Lancashire County Council's Welfare Rights service has published a booklet '60 plus benefits for you', which explains which benefits are available to people aged 60 and over.

The booklet also explains how you can access help with travel related expenses, household costs, health matters, support in your home and other useful information.

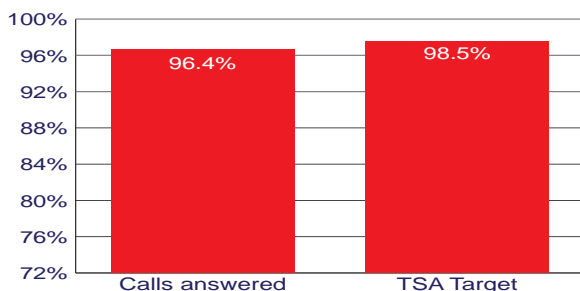

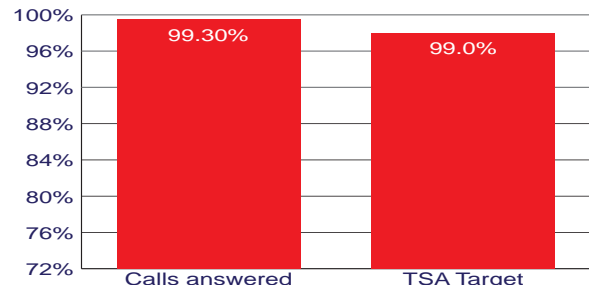
## Answering phone calls
