Safe and secure

For residents' safety and peace of mind each flat is connected to an alarm system. This enables residents to summon assistance 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Boundary Close and Churchside benefit from a scheme manager who is there to ensure the safety and well-being of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and other support services. The scheme manager will keep in contact either by personal visit or intercom call.

From Leyland:

Head southwest on King Street/B5256 towards Thurston Road, turn right onto Towngate/B5254. Continue onto School Lane. Turn left onto Golden Hill Lane, continue onto Long Meanygate. At the roundabout take the 4th exit onto Flensburg Way/B5253. At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Penwortham Way/A582. Turn left onto Chain House Lane, continue onto Wham Lane. Turn right onto Station Road, turn right onto Boundary Close.

There is a regular bus service to Preston.
