Bridge Court is a purpose-built sheltered scheme with ground and first floor flats and bungalows. This scheme is ideally located within a small housing development only a short walk to shops and local amenities.

Facilities

The scheme contains many communal facilities. It has two well appointed lounges where residents gather for social activities and coffee mornings. There is a laundry room equipped with washer and dryer and a communal kitchen. At Bridge Court there is a guest room. There is a visiting hairdresser and reflexologist and a computer for residents to use.



Social activities

This scheme offers a wide range of social activities for its residents to enjoy. There are coffee mornings, bingo afternoons and quiz nights. Throughout the summer months for those wishing to go further afield there are social excursions available.

Safe and secure

For resident's safety and peace of mind each flat is connected to an alarm system. This enables residents to summon assistance 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



Friendly scheme manager

Bridge Court benefits from a scheme manager who is there to ensure the safety and well being of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and other support services. The scheme manager will keep in contact either by personal visit or intercom call.

From Leyland:

From King Street/B5256 head towards Turpin Green Lane, turn left to stay on Turpin Green Lane. At the roundabout take the third exit onto Chapel Brow/B5254, turn right onto Station Brow/B5254 and continue to follow this road. Go through the next set of traffic lights and at the next roundabout take the second exit. Continue over a double bridge then at the second set of traffic lights turn left onto Coote Lane. Turn right onto Fir Trees Avenue and the first right onto Bridge Close.
