Mainway Court is a purpose built sheltered scheme situated in a quiet residential street, just off Station Road in Bamber Bridge. It's just a 10-minute level walk to the shops and bus stop.

Facilities

The scheme contains many communal facilities. It has a laundry room equipped with washer and dryer, and a kitchen for you to use when gathering in the homely lounge. There is a parking area for you and your visitors.



Social activities

At Mainway Court there are many events and activities including bingo, breakfasts, a hairdresser service and a monthly church service. The residents have recently set up a group to arrange a series of activities over the coming year. These events help people to settle in and get to know other residents but if all you want is a quiet evening in then that's OK too.

Central location

The scheme is close to a bus stop with a ten-minute service to Preston, and regular services to Chorley, Bolton and Leyland.



Friendly scheme manager

There is scheme manager available who can help you with arranging repairs and managing your tenancy. The scheme manager will keep in contact either by personal visit or intercom call.

Safe and secure

For your safety and peace of mind each flat is connected to an alarm system, which enables you to summon assistance 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Directions

From Leyland:

Travel along Turpin Green Lane (B52540) under the motorway bridge towards the traffic lights at the junction with the A49. Turn left signposted Preston. Continue forward onto Station Road (B6258), Bamber Bridge. Continue on for approximately half a mile and turn left into Edward Street. Mainway Court is on the right.

To Leyland: 112, 117, and 113

To Preston: 126 (every 10 minutes) and 113 (every 50 minutes)
