Location

Hennel House is an independent living scheme with excellent communal facilities including a garden, greenhouse and hobby room. The 31, one and two bed self-contained flats and bungalows each have their own lounge, kitchen and bathroom.

Located in a secluded area of Walton-le-Dale, Hennel House is perfect for those who enjoy the peacefulness of a rural location but do not want to be too far from local amenities.

The adjacent village of Bamber Bridge, with its good mix of shops, restaurants and pubs is only a short distance away. Excellent local transport links mean travelling to Preston, Chorley, and Blackpool and beyond is convenient.



Services

The scheme benefits from an independent living co-ordinator service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and the support services.

The scheme is also monitored by the Control Centre and should an emergency arise they can be contacted by pulling the red intercom cord or pressing a pendant. This service is available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

There are a wide range of optional social activities at the scheme ranging from bingo and coffee mornings to art clubs and day trips. Residents can take advantage of regular visits from the hairdresser as well as weekly transport to the local supermarket.
