Location

Stanner Lodge is an Extra Care scheme which means that it benefits from a team of care staff who are on site at all times. The residence contains 54 one bedroom apartments and bungalows.

Located close to the centre of St Annes, a beautiful seaside resort with a good range of shops, restaurants and amenities, Stanner Lodge is the perfect place to truly enjoy retirement.

The scheme is located close to a train station and on a bus route so travel to Blackpool along the beautiful Fylde Coast or inland past Preston to Lancashire's stunning rolling hills is convenient.

Services

The scheme benefits from an independent living co-ordinator service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and the support services. As an Extra Care scheme, we work with care and support providers who have a team on site that can provide services for those wanting additional support. In most cases this alleviates the need to immediately go into hospital or residential care when your condition becomes such that you cannot manage independently.

The scheme is also monitored by the Control Centre and should an emergency arise they can be contacted by pulling the red intercom cord or pressing a pendant. This service is available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

There are a wide range of optional social activities at the scheme ranging from coffee mornings and bingo to seasonal social activities, parties and coach trips.
