Location

Boundary Close and Churchside are independent living schemes in New Longton. Boundary Close has 29 bungalows and Churchside has 15 properties; 11 bungalows and four flats. Each property has its own lounge, kitchen, bathroom and garden.

Located on a quaint cul-de-sac in the village of New Longton, a former runner-up in Lancashire's Best Kept Village competition, these bungalows are perfect for anyone who cherishes their peace and quiet.

New Longton has several shops for your convenience and Longton Village, with its cafes, market, pubs and bowling club is only a five minute drive away.

Excellent public transport links mean that it is quick and easy to travel to Preston, Leyland and beyond.

About the scheme

The scheme benefits from an independent living co-ordinator service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and the support services.

The scheme is also monitored by the Control Centre and should an emergency arise they can be contacted by pulling the red intercom cord or pressing a pendant. This service is available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

There are a wide range of optional social activities at the scheme; from bingo and coffee mornings to a lunch club and day trips. A communal computer gives residents access to the internet and plenty of books can be found in the library.
