Location

Amounderness Court is an independent living scheme which is made up of 35 self-contained apartments on three floors connected by stairs and a lift. The scheme is only accessible through a door entry system for safety and security.

The scheme is conveniently located near to the centre of Kirkham; a market town with a good range of amenities including a supermarket, Post Office, library, doctors, cafes, leisure centre and independent shops. There are good transport links including a railway station in nearby Wesham.

Services

The scheme benefits from an independent living co-ordinator service to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents and to provide a link with doctors, families, friends and the support services.

The scheme is also monitored by the Control Centre and should an emergency arise they can be contacted by pulling the red intercom cord or pressing a pendant. This service is available 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year.

There are a wide range of optional social activities at the scheme ranging from coffee mornings and exercise classes to afternoon entertainment and concerts.
